Jeannette A. Rogowski is an internationally-recognized scholar that has over twenty years of experience in studying the economics of the health care system. She has published numerous peer-reviewed articles on health insurance, health care use and expenditures by vulnerable populations, and health care financing issues.

Dr. Rogowski has served on numerous national advisory committees such as the Institute of Medicine's Committee on Understanding Premature Birth and Assuring Healthy Outcomes and the Steering Committee for the National Institute on Aging's Health and Retirement Study.

Prior to joining UMDNJ, Dr. Rogowski was a Senior Economist at RAND. Dr. Rogowski holds a Ph.D. in Economics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. She is a Research Associate of the National Bureau of Economic Research and an Adjunct Senior Fellow of the Leonard Davis Institute of Health Economics at the University of Pennsylvania.
