#910A Social and Psychopathologies of Aging

This course provides a holistic examination of the dynamic interaction of psycho-social, cultural and biological factors that influence psychological wellness during aging. Older adults are viewed within the context of families, communities and the broader society. Preventive, diagnostic and intervention strategies of selected health alterations are discussed relevant to the practice of a broad range of professionals working with older adults. (5 units). This class is required for all students.

#501 MH Dementia

Professionals from diverse disciplines may encounter elderly clients with mental health disorders, discovering complex challenges that require skillful attention. In this course, participants will explore practical issues related to geriatric mental health. Group discussion will be emphasized (4 units)

#BD4 Best Practices

This course offers the fundamentals and intricacies of starting a care management practice from the ground up. The course focuses on care management models by exploring business development options, marketing strategies, legal issues and practice expansion through business assessment and re-evaluation. Class room discussion and assignments help to make this a practical learning experience.

#AN2 Institutional Care

Care for an older adult, whether it occur in an independent living, assisted living facility or a nursing home brings with it an adjustment for both the senior and his or her family. This course will explore the transition from home to the senior residence. The student will gain an understanding of what to expect in each of these facilities, the different guidelines that influence their running and how to effectively advocate for the client in his or her respective residence. Presenters from various residences will help provide an intimate understanding of day to day operations.
